Re: Public Records Act Request re: San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station

Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to the California Public Records Act, Government Code § 6250 *et seq.*, Friends of the Earth hereby requests any and all documents, records or materials—including communications oral or otherwise—relating to the following at Southern California Edison's San Onofre nuclear generating station from January 1, 2012 to the present.

1. Any inspections, testing, analysis, plugging or other measures concerning the steam generators at reactor units 2 and 3 at Southern California Edison's San Onofre nuclear generating station; and
2. Plans or other information regarding the restart of Edison's San Onofre reactor units 2 and 3 and plans by Southern California Edison or other entities for the alternative provision of electricity should the reactors not restart, including during the peak months of summer.

All documents, records and materials includes correspondence with Southern California Edison, San Diego Gas & Electric Company and/or the City of Riverside Utilities Department about the release of radiation from the San Onofre reactor Unit 3 on January 31, 2012.

Pursuant to Cal. Gov't Code § 6253(c), ***Friends of the Earth expects a response within ten (10) days of your receipt of this request.*** If this request is denied in whole or in part, we expect a detailed justification for withholding the records. We also request any segregable portions of records that are otherwise not expected to be disclosed by the California Public Utilities Commission in response to this request. Friends of the Earth reserves the right to appeal any denial of this request.

Friends of the Earth is a not-for-profit charitable organization with no commercial interest in the information requested and have relevant expertise in the areas of environment and human health and environmental law. Friends of the Earth has a long and active history in addressing threats to human health and the environment posed by nuclear power. We request a waiver of any and all

costs or fees associated with the completion of this request. If our request for a waiver of costs or fees is denied and any expenses associated with this request are in excess of \$25.00, please obtain our approval before any such charges are incurred.
