

## **National Survey Results**

Q1 Since 2008 American firms have engaged in one of the largest rounds of mergers in history, worth \$10 trillion. As a result of these mergers, there are now only 4 major national airlines in the US; five health insurance companies control 83% of the insurance market; and three retail companies control 99% of the drug stores in the country. Meanwhile four companies control 84% of the beef Americans eat and four firms control 60 percent of the chicken we eat. In the last year, the largest agricultural corporations that own nearly all the seeds for crops including corn, soybeans and cotton and nearly all the chemicals used in growing those crops agreed to merge - leaving only four huge companies that control nearly almost all seeds and agrichemicals.
