

Dear President Biden,

The shadow of a second Trump Administration hangs over the COP 29 climate negotiations in Baku. As we prepare to resist Donald Trump and his promises to unleash US LNG on the world, you must use the remaining days of your presidency to lock in as much climate progress as possible.

On behalf of over 282 organizations from over 37 countries around the globe, we call on the Biden Administration to use the time it has left to stop the further expansion of LNG infrastructure, globally and in the US. You must:

- Update the studies underlying the Department of Energy's public interest determination, taking into full account the climate, environmental justice, and consumer risks of LNG expansion.
- Reject all six LNG permits pending before the Department of Energy, including Venture Global's notorious CP2 project.
- Negotiate and finalize an agreement at the OECD to phase out support from export credit agencies for international oil and gas projects.
- Cancel all pending public financing for global LNG infrastructure, including rescinding over \$5 billion in support for LNG development in Mozambique from the US Export-Import Bank and US International Development Finance Corporation.

The explosion of LNG exports from the U.S. represents an extreme grab of the limited carbon budget remaining to constrain global temperature rise. This is especially egregious considering that the United States has already consumed far more than its fair share of the remaining carbon budget. Donald Trump, an impending nightmare for people and the planet, threatens to put this dynamic on steroids. But you still have opportunities for damage control.

The next four years will test the limits of global resistance against fossil fuels. The next two months should be spent doing all that we can to protect communities in the US, the Global South, and throughout the world. We implore you to not act as though your climate presidency ended on November 5th.
